

MyQ - TEO factsheet

This factsheet provides an overview of MyQ to help tertiary education organisations (TEOs) answer questions.

The MyQ website went live on the 22 December 2016. If you get questions about the tool you can tell them:

- MyQ is one of a number of tools providing learners with access to the information they need to explore opportunities and make informed decisions about tertiary study.
- The MyQ tool gathers feedback from graduates via a simple online satisfaction survey on the whole study experience, not only about being work-place ready.
- We engaged with a Working Group to provide input into MyQ and support the development.
- > The development and launch of the graduate survey is phase one.
- The results from graduates will be presented on the MyQ website in phase two of this stream in mid-2017.

- Publication of the results for each qualification is dependent on a minimum response rate being achieved.
- > No one other than a valid graduate should complete the survey.
- > The MyQ survey is a satisfaction based survey. This will likely show different results from your surveys because of the different methodology.
- > We'd like your help by encouraging your recent graduates to fill out the survey. A media pack to enable you to do this can be found here.
