The Youth Guarantee Fund 2013


The purpose of Youth Guarantee is to provide fees-free tertiary places for eligible domestic students aged 16 to 17 years who are studying towards a gualification at levels 1, 2, or 3 on the New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF) (including NCEA).

STUDENT PROFILE

The Youth Guarantee Fund provides opportunities for students from a range of backgrounds who have not achieved a foundation level gualification to achieve this in a tertiary setting and to progress to higher level study. Youth Guarantee also aims to increase overall achievement for Maori and Pasifika and to reduce the number of young people not in employment, education, or training (NEETs).




Total may exceed 100 percent as some students identify with more than one ethnicity



STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

The Youth Guarantee Fund enables students who have predominately not achieved higher than National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) Level 1 to progress to tertiary education. The majority of students successfully complete their course.


