



Key Information for Students The Process



This handout provides you with a quick view of the four high-level phases to publish the KIS to your website.



Phase One: Initiate

This phase is for you to become familiar with what the Key Information for Students is, how you want to implement it on your website and checking your data is up to date.

The **key tasks** during this phase are to:

- Ensure your data is up-to-date in STEO.
This will be the data that is displayed on the full KIS and on the KIS central website to users. You can find more information on the [KIS initiation webpage](#).
- Select a publishing option (full KIS or a KIS button).
Take a look at examples on the next page.
- Familiarise yourself with the implementation plan for your selected publishing option.

Once you have confirmed your publishing option, the TEC will notify you via email of your KIS implementation dates. You will receive a table like the example below.

Note: the weeks indicated in the 'Timing' row is 19 weeks for the full KIS and 8 weeks for the KIS button.

These rows outline the maximum duration each phase should take to complete.

These rows give you a description of what milestone is to be started or finished. Take a look below on the finer detail.

Phase Two: Design

This phase is when you work with the TEC on the design of the KIS on your website. This is to ensure the location and design of the KIS is aligned to the implementation plan and style guide for your selected publishing option.

Note: The timing for this phase is 4 weeks for the Full KIS and 1 week for the KIS button.

The **key tasks** during this phase are to:

- Design the KIS aligned to the style guide requirements.

- Submit your design for approval by the TEC.

Phase Three: Implement

This phase is for you to connect to the KIS Data Service (full KIS only) or to apply the KIS button to the relevant qualification pages on your website, linked to the KIS central website. **Note:** The timing for this phase is 4 weeks for both publishing options.

The **key tasks** during this phase are to:

- Publish the KIS to your website (as per the publishing option chosen).
- Notify the TEC when your implementation is completed, with links to the web pages.

Ongoing Maintenance

Please ensure you have processes in place to maintain the KIS and KIS data. This ensures that users will view up-to-date data and new qualification pages will include the KIS.

The **key tasks** during this phase are to:

- Update your course and qualification data whenever it changes.
- Notify TEC of any changes that will impact the publication of the KIS to your qualification pages.
- Apply the KIS to new qualification pages.
