

Infosheet: Post-Study Outcomes apps

This infosheet provides government-funded tertiary education organisations (TEOs) with key information about the new *Post-Study Outcomes of Young Graduates* and *Post-Study Outcomes by TEO* information products.

We have released these two *Post-Study Outcomes* information products to support engagement between TEOs and TEC on the outcomes of the tertiary provision they offer.

This infosheet builds on the key messages outlined in the 2018 Plan Guidance.

Post-Study Outcomes apps are part of the growing suite of performance tools

You can access these new *Post-Study Outcomes* information products via Ngā Kete.

Post-Study Outcomes of Young Graduates provides information about employment outcomes and earnings by level of study and NZSCED.

Post-Study Outcomes by TEO provides TEO-level data about outcomes for learners who completed qualifications by level of study, age, ethnicity, and gender.

These information products give TEOs detailed insights into the performance of their provision and the outcomes of learners' study or training. The information products enable TEC to make better, more informed decisions, from a consistent evidence base.

We expect TEOs to use this information about learners' employment outcomes when developing Plans for 2019-21 funding approval.

TEC and MoE have previously published data on post-study outcomes. The new information products have been designed to make this valuable dataset accessible, business-friendly, and relevant to TEOs.

Post-Study Outcomes of Young Graduates

This information product allows you to take an in-depth look into recent data on employment outcomes and median earnings for people who completed a tertiary qualification in 2010/11, 2012/13, or 2014/15.

The data uses Broad, Narrow, and Detailed New Zealand Standard Classification of Education (NZSCED) classifications to identify the subject areas people studied and includes the level of study completed (Certificate, Diploma, Degree etc.)

Examples of what you can see include:

- > Median incomes by NZSCED for people who completed tertiary qualifications one, three and five years before the 2016/2017 tax years.
- > Employment outcomes by NZSCED for people who completed a tertiary qualification one, three, and five years before the 2015/2016 calendar years.



- > Median income figures for people who completed qualifications at different levels of study.
- > The number of people completing tertiary study at different levels and in subject areas.

Post-Study Outcomes by TEO

This information product allows you to take an in-depth look into recent data on employment outcomes for people who completed a tertiary qualification in 2012/13 and 2015/16.

You use this information product to explore information about the outcomes for people who studied at different tertiary education providers. This data can be filtered by level of study completed (Certificate, Diploma, Degree etc.) and by learner attributes including Age, Ethnicity, and Gender.

Examples of what you can see include employment outcomes by TEO for people who completed a tertiary qualification one and three years before the 2015/2016 calendar years:

- > by age group, gender and ethnicity
- > by level of study
- > by highest school achievement.

How to get the most value from these information products

- You need access to Ngā Kete. The information products will be the only way to access your commitments, performance, and delivery data. - > Familiarise yourself with the post-study outcomes data as it appears in the information products.

Post-Study Outcomes information products are intended for use with our other information products

Post-Study Outcomes information provides insights into the benefits of tertiary study particularly in respect of employment and income outcomes. However this information will not be considered on its own. They are intended to be used alongside our other information products, which include:

- > My Performance
- > My Provision
- > Tertiary Provision
- > My Commitments
- > Secondary to Tertiary Transition

We want to reduce our investment in areas with poor post-study outcomes and use this funding to increase investment in better performing areas. However, we will engage with you first to understand what *Post-Study Outcomes* information tells us about likely outcomes for your learners and why this is the case. These discussions will consider all relevant information that is available.
