

MyQ Publishing Results

This handout outlines the key principles and publication options for your MyQ results.

Key principles

- MyQ gathers feedback from recent graduates to inform prospective learners and their whānau about qualifications. Once the minimum publication threshold has been met for a qualification, these results are published online.
- All TEO qualifications that meet the publication threshold will have the MyQ national and detailed results displayed on the corresponding careers.govt.nz qualification page.
- All TEOs have the ability to publish and/or link to these results from their website.

Publication threshold

The overarching publishing threshold is 50 valid and eligible responses. The below table outlines the publishing threshold per graduate pool size:

Graduate pool (completed the qualification in the last 3 years)	Number of eligible responses required to publish MyQ results
250+ graduates	50
51 – 250 graduates	25
50 or less graduates	5

Opt-out of publication

- All TEOs have the choice to opt-out of publishing MyQ national and detailed results.
- This would be applied to all qualifications for that TEO, not on a per qualification basis.

Opt-in to publication

- All TEOs are able to opt back in to publishing MyQ national and detailed results at any time.
- This would be applied to all qualifications for that TEO, not on a per qualification basis.

What will results look like?

Below is a draft example of what published MyQ results will look like on the Careers New Zealand qualification page.

MyQ national results

The MyQ national results will be published by Narrow NZSCED and Qualification Type as per the existing KIS outcomes data.

MyQ detailed results

The MyQ detailed results will be published for specific TEO qualifications that meet the publication threshold.
