### Transitions into tertiary education

- › *Secondary to Tertiary Transition* allows you to explore the transition of school leavers into tertiary education. The transition shown is the learners' first enrolment in qualification-based tertiary education when the enrolment occurs after they leave school.

### Provision

- › *Tertiary Provision* uses enrolment data from the Single Data Return (SDR) and the Industry Training Register (ITR) to provide a picture of who is enrolling in tertiary education and industry training, what they are studying and training, and where.

- › *My Provision SDR* uses the SDR course enrolment information to provide a picture of who is enrolling in tertiary education, what they are studying, and where. It allows you to review your own enrolment information.
