Capability in delivering high-quality provision	<p>The Applicant demonstrates the capability, experience, skills and organisational capacity to apply pedagogical best practice to deliver high-quality learning and to ensure students successfully complete their courses.</p> <p>We will consider the narrative provided in Part A of the application form, EPI course completion and retention measures, as well as qualification description information recorded in the Services for Tertiary Education Organisations (STEO) system.</p>	40
3. Experience targeting and supporting students	<p>The Applicant demonstrates how it ensures students are adequately informed about primary sector employment requirements and opportunities.</p> <p>The Applicant demonstrates how it works with local communities (including Māori and Pasifika groups) to attract, support and retain students within the primary sector focus areas, particularly students in priority groups identified in the Tertiary Education Strategy 2014-19.</p> <p>We will consider the narrative provided in Part A of the application form, and the EPI participation rate for Māori and Pasifika students.</p>	20
